Amount left to be raised by Apr 1/24 to be debt free: \$244,043

In addition, the Debt Repayment Fund will receive funds by year end from:

- Operations designated surplus

Note: TICA event income goes into the Food and Event Services account held for accumulative transfers for Debt Repayment.

Back into the Black Update

TICA's Back into the Black program is an effective and predictable way to repay the debt incurred by the Forbes Hall Expansion project. In the first six months of 2022, the campaign has already raised \$90,957 in donations and pledges.
